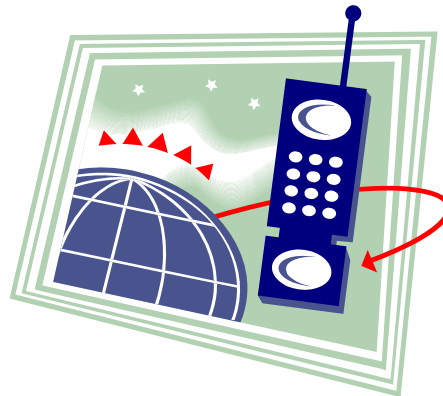
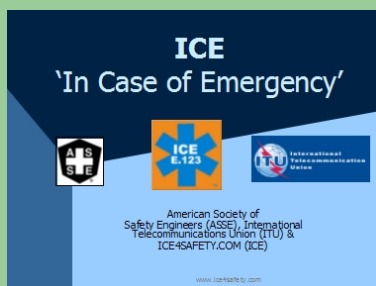

ICE4SAFETY.COM in cooperation with the United Nations Agency, International Telecommunications Union (ITU) is recommending a *non-language based* standard for international use of ICE in parts of the world where Latin based languages are not spoken or recognized.

On your cell phone or other electronic communication device allowing storage of emergency contact information you will identify your emergency contact numbers numerically if your phone does not already have a preloaded emergency contact folder system. Listed this way, your contacts will be identified immediately as being for emergency purposes as they will be first on your contact list.

It is also recommended that you identify your phone with the ICE Symbol. The new **ICE.123** Symbol is shown in the margin. The new symbol combines the original ICE symbol with the E.123 reference so the two can be used interchangeably. Examples of how this standard might be used in the USA to notify relatives, partners, next of kin:

**01Emergency, 02Doctor, 03Mother, 04Work or 05ICE**
